

### Items Accepted (subject to change)

- Aerosol cans
- Ammunition—spent cartridges only
- Antifreeze
- Batteries (household, rechargeable, cell phone, automotive, boat)
- Cooking oil
- Drain cleaners
- Fluorescent bulbs (including CFL)
- Fuels (gasoline, diesel, propane)
- Herbicides & Pesticides (household only—no commercial or agricultural)
- Household cleaners
- Motor oil & filters
- Paints, thinners, solvents & stains\*
- Pool chemicals (household only)
- Thermometers & thermostats
- Tires, Limit 6 (automobile, pickup truck or smaller – removed from wheels)

*\*Latex paint can be dried and safely disposed of with regular household trash*

### Items Not Accepted

- Explosives
- Household appliances
- Lawn & yard waste
- Live ammunition
- Medical waste (syringes)
- Pharmaceuticals
- Radioactive materials

### Transporting items

- Do not mix chemicals
- Do not eat, drink or smoke when handling household hazardous waste
- Do not transport materials in the same part of your vehicle as passengers or pets
- Keep products in their original containers
- Place items in a box to prevent spills
- Gasoline & other fuel is highly explosive and should only be transported in cans or containers designed for that purpose
- Wash hands after handling household hazardous waste materials

**Quantity Accepted is Limited to:  
FIVE GALLONS, PER PRODUCT, PER VISIT**

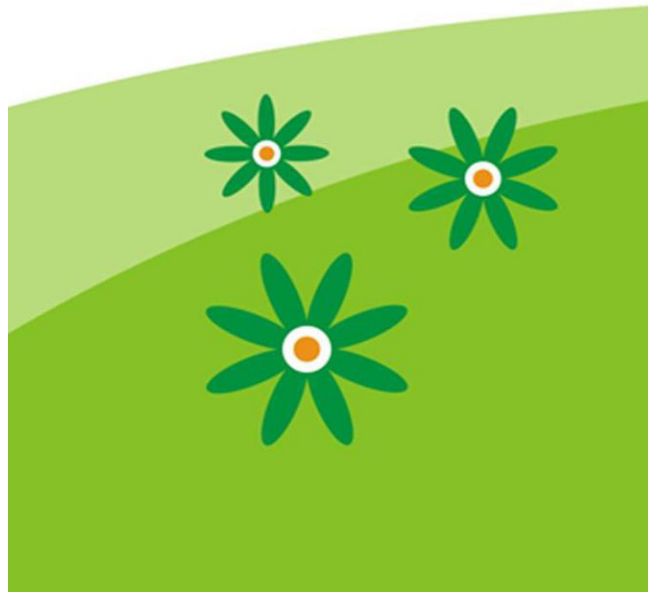

The Greenville-Hunt County Regional Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility is available to residents of member cities and residents in unincorporated areas of Hunt County through use of a **VOUCHER SYSTEM**. A limited number of vouchers are available to residents each year.

Residents of participating cities and unincorporated areas of Hunt County must first obtain a voucher before dropping off items at the HHW facility.

Contact your local City Hall or City Administration office to obtain a voucher.

Greenville residents may obtain a voucher from the Municipal Annex Building.

Hunt County residents may contact the Hunt County Judge's Office at the Courthouse.

Voucher supplies are limited and only a certain number will be made available each year.

A driver's license must be presented with the voucher at the time of item drop-off.
